

Step 1. Install the CPU

Mark your CPU Frequency: Record the working frequency of your CPU, it should be clearly marked on the CPU cover

300MHz (66 x 4.5)	333MHz (66 x 5.0)	366MHz (66 x 5.5)
400MHz (66 x 6.0)	433MHz (66 x 6.5)	

 $\pmb{CPU \ Mount \ Procedure:}$ To mount the Celeron $^{\text{TM}}$ processor that you have purchased separately, follow these instructions.



- 1. Lift the socket handle up to a vertical position.
- 2. Align the blunt edge of the CPU with the matching edge on the socket.
- 3. Seat the processor in the socket completely and without forcing it in.
- 4. Then close the socket handle to secure the CPU in place.



Remember to connect the CPU Cooling Fan to the appropriate power connector on the Motherboard. The fan is a key component that will ensure system stability. The fan prevents overheating, therefore prolonging the life of your CPU.
